Sister Port Agreement signed between Nanaimo and Taiwan City

Nanaimo has signed a strategic trade agreement with Taiwan's largest port, expanding global market access. This move positions Nanaimo as a vital gateway for Canadian exports, reducing reliance on U.S. trade routes. The partnership is expected to stimulate local job creation in logistics, warehousing, and marine services. 

BC's unemployment rate was up slightly in July compared to June, with the Vancouver Island region reflecting an increase from 4% to 5.9% (note: the unemployment rate is a percentage of a region's labour force, not a percentage of the entire population).

StrongerBC Future Skills Grant

BC residents over age 19 can continue to access grants for eligible short-term training programs at public post-secondary institutions, giving them more opportunities to gain new skills for in-demand jobs.
