► The threat of automation has made many people anxious about the future of their jobs. Automated trucks could one day soon replace truckers. Even pizza delivery could now be done through automation. But as some jobs wane (as has always been the case with advancement — chances are you don't see positions open for lamplighters any more, either), other positions are created or grow in demand. 2018 will see certain jobs become more in demand as the nature of our world changes. Daniel Culbertson, economist at job search site Indeed.com, says that there are plenty of jobs that humans need to do, even as automation grows. "...The occupations at greatest risk are those that are comprised largely of routine tasks easily replicated by machines or software. It is also important to keep in mind that automation may not always be a destructive force, but rather will likely create new jobs as well."
