## Business Buzz

► Greyhound received permission to stop bus service in several areas of BC, meaning the bus company's two remaining routes on Vancouver Island — connecting Victoria to Nanaimo and Vancouver - will be scrapped. Tofino Bus Services have announced that it will be stepping in to serve those travellers by expanding its routes to include more communities. Last November the company was approved by the BC Passenger Transportation Board to increase its service to three times a day and add smaller communities including Duncan, Mill Bay, Chemainus, Cowichan, and Ladysmith to its schedule.

► Construction is expected to begin in March or April on The Nanaimo Airport’s terminal, which, once completed, will see it increase by 14,000 square feet. The \$14-million project, which includes \$5 million in funding from the federal and provincial governments, will see expansions to the terminal’s departure lounge, baggage and security screening areas and is expected to be completed by 2019. It’s the first phase of a 20-year \$55-million expansion plan for the airport that will eventually see the terminal expand from 23,680 square feet to 70,395 square feet. <http://bit.ly/2DIYbiX>

► Nanaimo City Council passes third reading of a zoning amendment bylaw for the old Madill site. The project, to be called Madill City Centre, borders Kenworth Road, Labieux Road and the old Island Highway. Plans show Labieux connecting to Kenworth and meeting at a roundabout. The hearing, held Thursday at the Vancouver Island Conference Centre, related to re-zoning another lot at the location for automotive sales and service. Two other lots on the Madill City Centre site are spoken for by new

automotive dealerships. Other plans for the property include office space, mixed use, and a seniors' care facility. <http://bit.ly/2lFqr9l>

► Wertman Development Corp. has bought two Nanaimo sites — one for a downtown condo tower of 20-plus storeys and another for a two-building rental project. The two neighbouring Nanaimo parking lots are located at 66 and 77 Chapel St., and another site purchased by Wertman is located on Third Street, near Vancouver Island University. The Chapel Street properties would house a 90-unit boutique condominium tower, to be called the Maraciello. Concept drawings are in the works, with the height possibly between 22 and 25 storeys, Wertman said. Plans call for about four to six suites per floor, mainly two-bedroom units. The adjacent building would stand two storeys tall on the Chapel Street side of the site, rising to four storeys on the Skinner Street side behind it. This building would house about six townhouses, a retail space, and a gym and pool. The commercial space could contain a restaurant or a grocery store. The project would require a rezoning and development permit, he said. Applications will likely be submitted to the city in January.

► The Regional District of Nanaimo will receive \$6 million in federal gas tax money, which will go toward wastewater upgrades at the Greater Nanaimo Pollution Control Centre. The \$81.7-million project will see construction of secondary treatment facilities at the Hammond Bay Road centre, allowing wastewater to be treated with micro-organisms, which in turn will lessen the effluent's impact on the environment. Sean De Pol, regional district manager of wastewater services, said the current primary wastewater plant will remain and work with the new addition. Bill Veenhof, RDN board chairman, said "It'll have a corresponding reduction in the tax load for the constituents, mostly the city, there'll be some benefit to Lantzville and [Snuneymuxw First Nation] and [Nanaimo Port Authority] and the Nanaimo Regional General Hospital." Veenhof indicated the regional district will continue to apply for money for the project as grants become available. The project is on schedule, with major excavation and ground stabilization nearing completion and foundations for buildings laid. Process tanks and equipment will be installed and startup is expected in 2020. <http://bit.ly/2FYUhsK>

► A 50-unit supportive housing project is planned for Parksville as part of the province's effort to deliver 2,000 modular units throughout the province. The provincially-funded initiative will cost \$6.9 million dollars, with the Regional District of Nanaimo also providing \$660,000 towards the development. The project is expected to have a major impact on those in Oceanside experiencing homelessness, which as of the last count in 2013 was 67 people. The modular units will be built at 222 Corfield St. S., and 24/7 staffing will be provided by the Island Crisis Care Society, who run existing shelters in the mid-Island area. It will house those at a high-risk of homelessness and also seniors and people with disabilities. The supports planned for the housing include life and employment skills training and health services helping them move towards a more stable life. There will also be space allotted for a cold weather shelter operating from November to March, though it's unknown how many it will house. ## General LMI

► North Island College (NIC) in Campbell River is building a 42,000-square-foot, \$17.6-million new trades training facility in response to a growing demand for skilled workers as Vancouver Island's brisk construction activity continues to spread northward. The expansion – the largest project undertaken by NIC since it opened its campus doors in Campbell River in 1997 – will include heavy duty mechanics, electrical, metal fabrication and welding courses and programs. It will also be home to forestry, aeronautical and aquaculture, the latter being one of the new industries taking shape on the island. The college also started a 24-week Carpentry Foundation course in January at its Port Alberni campus. It prepares students for entry into the Red Seal apprenticeship program. <http://bit.ly/2GlpKnW>
