#### **Mandatory Abestos Certification**

All workers in British Columbia covered by the regulation must obtain their asbestos abatement certification by January 1, 2024, to continue working on any site where asbestos is present. WorkSafeBC must also license asbestos abatement contractors by January 1, 2024, and ensure their workers are certified for their work by January 1, 2024.

# BCCA's apprenticeship services project hits \$10m milestone

The BC Construction Association's Apprenticeship Services project provides employer participants with cash incentives to hire and register first-year apprentices in various Red Seal trades. ## What is the StrongerBC future skills grant program?

The StrongerBC future skills grant is open to British Columbians aged 19 years or older – regardless of financial need – and covers up to \$3,500 in eligible short-term skills training at public post-secondary institutions. Find out what public post-secondary institutions qualify **here**.

## New technologies reduce employment barriers for people with disabilities

People with disabilities will have better employment opportunities with personalized technologies funded through a \$1-million grant to **CanAssist**, an organization based at the University of Victoria (UVIC). This grant complements WorkBC's Assistive Technology Services, which provide supports to help people thrive in the workplace, including ergonomic and mobility supports, communication and hearing devices, as well as workplace and vehicle modifications.

# Older Workers seeking more entry-level employment opportunities: Report

- 79% of employers plan to hire more staff in the second half of this year
- 54% of companies would prefer to hire an older worker than a younger one for an entry level role
- 33.6% of job seekers over 50 years old believe they have experienced ageism while looking for a new employer
- 86% of job seekers say it's appropriate to apply for jobs you're overqualified for if it's a position you want
